

Return Empty Packaging Checklist

The following checklist is designed to make returning empty packaging quick and hassle-free. **Packaging should meet the 7 criteria outlined below.** ▼

1

Is packaging completely empty according to local regulatory guidelines?

2

Is the packaging properly closed with all lids and caps attached?

3

Is the outside of the package free of product and residue?

4

Is the original labeling still in place and clearly visible with no obstructions (product name, bottler, UN marking)?

5

Is the package and pallet in reusable condition?

6

Are the Safety Data Sheets of the last product available for inquiries?

7

If the last filling good was toxic, flammable, carcinogenic, mutagenic, or excessively hazardous, has the package been decontaminated and clearly labeled as "NEUTRALIZED" or triple-rinsed as mandated by local regulatory agencies?

If packaging does not meet the conditions described above, additional costs may be incurred.
